The Catholic Handbook for Visiting the Sick and Homebound 2019

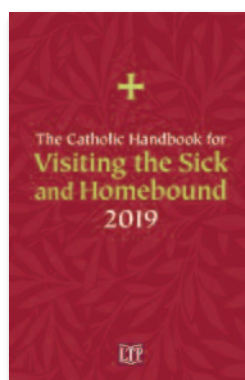
