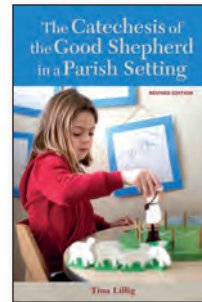

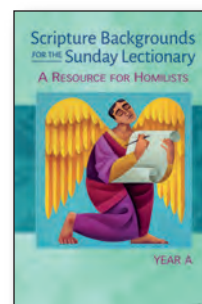


Guide for Training Initiation Ministers

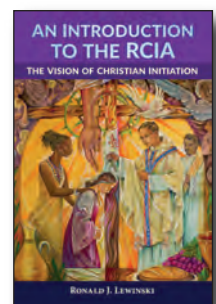
