ought – should; used to express what needs to be done

pleased – feeling happy or satisfied

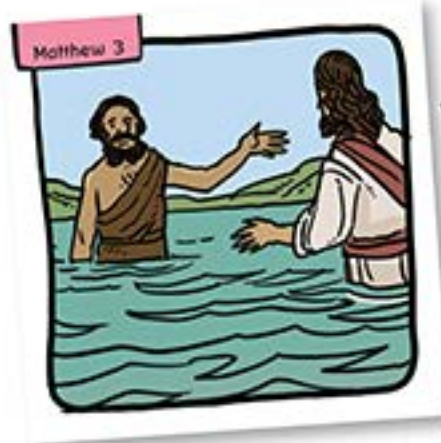
prophet – a person God has chosen to speak God's message

Heaven Opens Up
