We learn how the psalms express the people's response to God, then and now, in prayers of praise, gratitude, trust, complaint, sorrow for sin, and hope in God's mercy. The author demonstrates the fascinating way the psalms operate in the Mass, the privileged setting for the Word of God—how they interact with the meanings of the other readings and allow the assembly to voice the key insights for the day.
