He passed away in 2024.




The Sacrament of Reconciliation, Second Edition is a comprehensive and accessible resource for undergraduate, graduate, and seminary courses on the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It offers an overview of the sacrament in terms of its anthropological, scriptural, historical, and theological roots as well as an analysis of the key components of the sacrament itself (matter, form, minister, recipient, etc.). With the knowledge of a theologian and the skill of a historian, Robert Fastiggi links the sacrament to its anthropological foundations, grounded in the recognition of human failure and the need for forgiveness.

This anthropological foundation includes a brief overview of how non-biblical religions deal with sin and purification as well as the revelation of the human need for reconciliation presented in Sacred Scripture. He carefully unwraps the Old Testament and New Testament narratives that cover original sin, human rebellion, the need for reconciliation, conversion, forgiveness, and the remission of sin. His section on the sacrament in Church history lays out comprehensive overview of the development from the Patristic period to the period immediately before Vatican II.


The original edition of this book, in 1988, presented a theology of sacraments that emerged out of a Church stirred into new life by the Second Vatican Council. This second edition has the advantage of being able to look not only at the reception of its contents, but also at the way some countercurrents have developed over those years, both in theory and in practice. This study in sacramental theology examines the mainstream church teaching and practice and the alternatives that have emerged after the Second Vatican Council. Biblical and historical studies continue to uncover new riches of the tradition, and account is taken of recent findings in this edition. It has also been revised in light of the new translation of the *Order of Christian Initiation of Adults*.

LIAM G. WALSH is a member of the Irish Dominican Province. He holds degrees in theology from the Dominican Faculty of Theology of Le Saulchoir (France) and from the Angelicum (Rome). He has taught in Ireland, in Rome at the Angelicum, and was an ordinary professor of theology at the University of Fribourg in Switzerland from 1988 to 1999. He returned to Ireland in 2000, where he then taught in the Dominican Studium and collaborated with the Priory Institute in their distance learning program. He retired from teaching in 2023. While in Rome, he served for nine years as an Assistant to the Master of the Dominicans, with responsibility for studies in the order. Much of his theological work has been in the area of liturgy and the theology of sacraments. He has also been active in ecumenism; he was a consultor of the Pontifical Council for Christian Unity and was a member of ARCIC II from 1991 to 2005.
