IMPORTANT – READ BEFORE USING THE DVD*

Compatibility issues with Windows 7, 8 & 10

Project & Play is a collection of PDF files of the words and embedded music files of over 300 hymns. It was originally designed to be used with Adobe Reader software. In 2010 Adobe released version X (10.0) which changed the way media files (such as .mp3 music files) were played under Windows 7, 8 & 10. This updated software meant that the hymn verses could still be projected but the music files would not play. However, by using different PDF software such as Foxit Reader, Project & Play can still be used. Using Project & Play with Mac OS X is not affected.

Before using the DVD*

Download and install Foxit Reader

- 1 Go to:
www.foxitsoftware.com/products/pdf-reader/
and download the free Foxit Reader install app.
The Foxit website should detect which type of computer you are using (Windows, Mac, Linux etc).
- 2 The software should download to your web browser's download folder.
- 3 Go to your web browser's download folder and open the Foxit Reader install file.
- 4 Click 'Run' and follow the instructions.
- 5 Restart your computer/device.

** The music on this DVD can only be played through a computer with a DVD drive. Project & Play is a DVD data disc and not the same as a DVD movie disc.*

Setting up for the first time

Change the Preferences

- 6 Open the Foxit Reader app.
- 7 Go to 'File...' and 'Preferences' and change the following...
 - Select 'Documents' and uncheck 'Alert user when documents request Full Screen'
 - Select 'File Associations' and click on 'Make default PDF viewer'
 - Select 'General' and uncheck 'Show Advertisement' and 'Show floating promotion page'
 - Select 'Trust Manager' and uncheck 'Enable Safe Reading Mode'
 - Select 'Updater' and check 'Do not download and install updates automatically'

Foxit Reader Q&As

- Q** Won't stay in Full Screen Mode
A Press F11 on your keyboard.
- Q** How do I advance from one screen to the next
A Press the left (<-->) and (--->) right arrows on the keyboard.
- Q** Text is too large on the screen
A Press F11 on your keyboard.
